Regulations for awarding NAWA scholarships financed by the STER program

§1. General provisions

- The scholarships are intended for the best foreign doctoral students of the Graduate School of Physics and Chemistry, and for the best Polish doctoral students pursuing studies in international cooperation with the intention of obtaining a joint or double PhD degree.
- 2. The funds for the scholarships come from the STER program *Internationalization of doctoral schools* implemented in 2022-24.
- 3. The maximum amount of the scholarship is PLN 5,000 gross gross and is subject to health and social contributions to the Social Insurance Institution.
- Scholarships are awarded for 12 months with the possibility of extension after the application is approved by the Commission. In special cases scholarships can be awarded for shorter times.

§2. Scholarship Commission

- 1. Scholarships are awarded by a Commission composed of members of the Graduate School Council.
- 2. The decisions of the Commission are taken by a simple majority of votes.
- 3. The Commission makes an assessment on the basis of the submitted documents and the course of studies.
- 4. In special cases, the Commission may invite the applicant to an interview.
- 5. The decisions of the Commission are final and may not be appealed against.

§3. Requirements

- 1. Interested persons submit an application for a scholarship.
- 2. The application may be submitted after the approval of the individual research plan.
- 3. Applications will be considered no more than once every three months.
- 4. The application is submitted on the form available on the website of the Graduate School.
