## Regulations for awarding scholarships for research trips financed by the STER program

## §1. General provisions

- The scholarships are intended for doctoral students of the Graduate School of Physics and Chemistry
- 2. Scholarships cover travel, subsistence and insurance costs.
- 3. The funds for the scholarships come from the STER program *Internationalization of doctoral schools* implemented in 2022-24.

## §2. Scholarship Commission

- 1. Scholarships are awarded by a Commission composed of members of the Graduate School Council.
- 2. The decisions of the Commission are taken by a simple majority of votes.
- 3. The decisions of the Commission are final and may not be appealed against.

## §3. Requirements

- 1. Interested persons submit an application for a scholarship.
- 2. The application for a scholarship must include:
  - personal data
  - the supervisor's opinion
  - indication of a foreign research center
  - justification of the need for departure
  - justification for the need to obtain funding from the STER program
  - list of publications and conference presentations.
- 3. The Commission makes an assessment on the basis of the submitted documents and the course of studies.
- 4. After receiving a positive decision from the Commission, the candidates submit a confirmation of readiness for admission by a foreign research institution within 30 days.
- 5. Persons who received a scholarship are required to submit a report no later than 30 calendar days after returning from the trip.
